To all parents of pupils at Glebe House School and Nursery

I have great pleasure in sharing with you our ISI Educational Quality inspection report.

The report is presented in three sections, the first of which is in relation to the Regulatory Compliance Inspection. This looks at various different areas of compliance and you will notice that some of the standards were not met. With two members of extra-curricular activity staff, extra checks in addition to their DBS checks had not been made in the way that satisfied the inspection team. These staff are known to the school as members of our community and at no point was there a risk to any child under their supervision. Allow me to reassure you now that the checks have now been put in place and that all action points have already been addressed and completed.

The second section of the report comments on the quality and standards of our EYFS foundation stage, which as a registered setting incorporates the nursery and specifically the children aged 0-2. You will note that in all categories, the nursery was found to be **outstanding**. I am delighted that the nursery team has been recognised in this way.

The third section of the report relates to the Education Quality Inspection of the non-registered EYFS, Pre-Prep and Prep School. There are two sections for this part of the report:

- a) The achievement of the pupils, including their academic development, and
- b) The personal development of the pupils.

ISI must judge these two areas in with one of the following headline judgements; *excellent, good, sound or unsatisfactory*.

In both of these categories, Glebe House School was judged to be **excellent**. What pleased me the most was that the inspectors in their short visit gained an understanding of what makes Glebe special. I was bursting with pride at the feedback we received regarding the pupils and all of the staff.

I am excited now to continue the excellent work that we have been recognised for and we will continue to provide an **outstanding** and **excellent** education to the children in our care. I am truly proud to be Headmaster of this wonderful school.
